READ Hebrews 9:11-14, 10:11-18

1. Read Hebrews 9 and identify some of the ways the first covenant's tent/tabernacle and sacrificial system pointed to the age of the new covenant.

2. Explain what the following scriptures say about the "perfect tent" (Hebrews 9:11)?

John 2:19-22

Acts 17:24

Isaiah 66:1

3. Examine the differences between the sacrifices of the blood of Christ versus the blood of animals (Hebrews 7:27, 9:12, 10:11, 10:18). Envision what your daily focus would be if you had to rely on the sacrifices of animals for your sin.

4. What does Christ's blood purify that the animal's blood did not (Hebrews 9:13-14)? What does this purification enable us to do?
5. What verb in Hebrews 9:14 reveals Christ's willingness to fulfill the purpose of His incarnation? Describe His purpose and determination (Mark 10:45; Luke 9:51; John 12:27; 1 Tim. 1:15).
6. Describe the daily position, location and status of the priest in Hebrews 10:11 compared to the position, location and status of Christ (Hebrews 10:11-13; Psalm 8:6, 110:1). What does this indicate concerning today and the future?
7. "Sanctification means the impartation of the holy qualities of Jesus to meSanctification is an impartation, not an imitation." (My Utmost for His Highest (July 23) by Oswald Chambers) Explain the ministry of the Holy Spirit in "those who are being sanctified" (Hebrews 10:14-17; John 14:26, 16:13; 2 Corinthians 3:16-18)?
