

The God Who Is (November 14, 2021) “The God Who is Powerful”

OPENING QUESTION:

SERMON DISCUSSION: How were you impacted by the sermon? What new thoughts or lessons did you discover? In what ways did you find yourself challenged and/or encouraged?

READ Psalm 33:6-22

1. Identify the evidence of the powerful and creative word of God from Psalm 33:6-9.
2. What do you discover regarding God’s powerful plans in Psalm 33:10-12 (Job 42:2)? Recall instances from scriptures where God’s plans prevailed over the plans of man.
3. After considering God’s powerful plans in Question 2, give examples from Psalm 33:13-22, other scriptures, and from your own personal observances in life of the futility of self-reliance. Where should we place our hope and why?

4. Explain what Psalm 33:18-19 and 2 Chronicles 16:9a indicate about God and what is your response to your findings?

5. Psalm 33:20 says the Lord is our help and shield. Consider some reasons that you need God's help and from what might you need to be shielded?

6. Psalm 33:18 & 22 refer to the steadfast love of the Lord. Define "steadfast". Discuss what it means that the powerful God has a steadfast love for those who fear Him. Do you fear Him?
