OPENING QUESTION:

Fulfilled (Matthew 28:1-7)?

Verified (1 Corinthians 15:5-8)?

4. Paul as an eyewitness of the resurrected Christ, shared the gospel with others. Who witnessed to you about Christ? How have you been a witness to others concerning Christ?

5. Read Acts 7:58, 8:1-3, 9:1-2; 1 Corinthians 15:9-11 and describe what Paul was doing when Christ appeared to him. Discuss the power of God's grace in his life. Share how you have experienced God's grace in your own life?
