How To Use This Workbook

When we come to God in prayer we typically find a place inside a building or outside watching a sunrise, sunset, or listening to the birds as the wind blows through the trees. We are either by ourselves or with a group of other believers.

Picture what was around you, what you heard, saw, or the feeling of the wind or the heat of the sun. You can still *see* those places when you close your eyes.

We like to look back at the moments in our lives and remember the color of the sky, the leaves on a tree, or even the people around us. That is why we paint, draw, take pictures or write.

Composing music or poems can be an expression of prayer and can create an emotional connection with God. Imagine the music at a coffee shop. Most of the time you don't even notice the tune or rhythm until you focus on it.

The exercises in this workbook are designed to help you visually focus and organize your thoughts about prayer and those moments. You do not have to finish the workbook if you already know what you want to create.

This is to help you appreciate and engage with our creator God. Have fun and enjoy visualizing your prayer moments on paper.

For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you,


but if you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.


By day the LORD commands his steadfast love, and at night his song is with me, a prayer to the God of my life.


O God, hear my prayer; give ear to the words of my mouth.


