| • | What does it mean to be "meek"? |
| • | Why is meekness often considered an unattractive quality? |
| • | Think of a gentle and humble person you know. Do you find them attractive? Why? How is God glorified in their meekness? |
| • | Later in <u>Matthew 11:28-29</u> , Jesus describes Himself using the same word for "meek", sometimes translated "gentle". Why would Jesus describe Himself as "meek"? |
| • | The quietness, openness, and vulnerability of meekness is very beautiful—and very painful. It goes against all that we are in our sinful nature. It requires supernatural help. Read <u>James 1:19-21</u> . What does James teach us about how God works meekness into His people? |
| • | What does it mean to "inherit the earth"? |
| • | Read Roman 8:16-17 . What does God teach us about what it means for the meek to inherit the earth? |
| • | Pray together in light of this week's beatitude. Christ-like meekness is marked by submission to the Lord, and confidence that He loves you. Ask God: Is there any place in my life where I am free to die to self because I know I belong to Jesus? |
