2 Samuel 6:1-15 (5/4/2025)

SERMON DISCUSSION: How were you impacted by the sermon? What new thoughts or lessons did you discover? In what ways did you find yourself challenged and/or encouraged?

READ 2 Samuel 6:1-15, 1 Chronicles 15:1-3, 11-15, 25-28

1. Who was David's counsel in determining to bring the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem? (Hint: Consider 1 Chronicles 13:1-3.) What was missing from David's plan?

2. Have you ever planned a significant effort for God or for his church or for someone else that just seemed to fall flat? How did you feel? Can you relate to how David felt after Uzzah was struck dead? What would have made the situation better?

3. What was the difference between the first time David tried to bring the Ark to Jerusalem and the second time? How did these differences come about?

4. How was David's heart different the second time that the Ark was moved?

5. How does the Ark of the Covenant point to Jesus Christ?

6. What lessons do you take away from David's experience regarding worship individually? Regarding worship as a gathered people?

Consider praying, together, for the Lord's help in focusing our individual hearts on him continuously, and worshipping Jesus for his great salvation as the perfect lamb, sacrificed to make a way for us to be reconciled to our just, righteous and holy, and yet loving and merciful God.
